Mother Teresa's Missionaries of Charity were invited to work in a large archdiocese in the United States. The bishop appointed a board to support the Sisters in their new diocesan mission. At the first meeting of the board, to which Mother Teresa was invited, of course, the group gathered in the diocesan headquarters, around the long wooden conference table with the swivel chairs. Each place was marked with a new yellow pad and pen and bottled spring water. Mother Teresa offered the prayer and then fired the board. She felt they (which may well have included the bishop) just didn't *get it*. Truth be told, we don't have to have the best of everything. We're not supposed to follow the pattern of the world, rather the gospel is our pattern. "Own nothing." Jesus said. Mother Teresa did her reading and took care of her correspondence in the morning by a window, where there was natural light. She used as little electricity as possible. "If the poor don't have electricity, neither should we," she'd say. Now of course, Mother Teresa would get on a jet to go to visit the poor and her religious sisters, and the oxygen which assisted her on her death bed was electrically generated, but at least she knew we are to take none of these things for granted and that as disciples of Jesus Christ, we're to minimize things and struggle, even a bit, with regards to what we do own.
