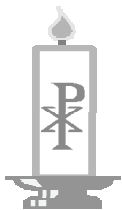

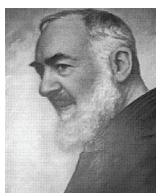

**OUR WEEKLY
COLLECTIONS: JULY 2011**

This past week I did a monthly comparison between July 2010 and July 2011. The contributions for the four weeks of July 2010 amounted to \$69,797. The same four weeks of July 2011 amounted to \$63,693.—a decline of \$6,104. in one month. There has been a steady erosion in our Church offerings during July for the past two years. This year-to-date's decline is \$31,000. We have to attempt to reverse this trend.

I would ask that we make up the contributions we might have made if we were away for July on vacation. When I returned from my four weeks away, I added each week's offering and made out a check for the full amount to the parish—a reminder to me that our parish has ongoing summer needs that must be met.

Also, I have noticed many adults 'watch the basket go by.' They may be using electronic mail or donating once a month or according to some other frame of reference. If you are not in any of these groups, please make a reasonable and just donation each week in the basket.

Also, YOUNG PEOPLE—you have an opportunity and responsibility to help maintain Maria Regina Church. It's not just for us 'older folks.' The Sunday contributions help fund many, if not all, of our ongoing activities for people of every age.

Please consider this appeal and help bring the collection back to where it should be or even higher. The greater the contributions, the more we can achieve.
