Dear Monsignor Pflomm:

Six months ago today, the island Republic of Haiti awoke to a violent and catastrophic earthquake that leveled almost completely the capital of Port-au-Prince and many other cities and villages in this Caribbean nation that was already dependent on humanitarian aid after decades of repression. The statistics of this human tragedy remain devastating: Over 300,000 dead, 250,000 injured, and over 1.5 million left homeless.

The Diocese of Rockville Centre responded almost immediately to this disaster in the early hours of January 12th, sending a substantial amount of funds through the Apostolic Nunciature in Port-au-Prince within 24 hours, and starting a diocesan-wide relief effort. The response of the people to this effort is something that all should appreciate with pride.

At this point, six months after the crisis, the parishes of our diocese have donated \$1,161,041.93 for relief. Separately we also received funds from schools and other institutions and Religious communities in the Diocese giving us a total of \$1,304,710.

While the relief efforts will continue for many years, the Diocese has also responded more concretely through the shipment of liturgical materials, which are urgently needed noting that most churches were completely destroyed. Others have set up through parishes or other agencies the shipment of medical and other material needs. Of special merit were the relief works done on the ground in the Dominican Republic by Msgr. John Cervini, Sister Beatrice Barry, CSJ, and Sister Jane Reilly, CSJ, our missionaries in the DR, who were aided both by many of the permanent deacons of the Diocese as well as by their own benefactors, family and friends.
